'Little Miss' form a neat clump of arching blades which emerge green, then go carmine-purple, while center leaves stay fresh green, for a striking two-tone effect. Coloration peaks October to November. Reddish plumes mature to buff in late Summer. Very vigorous & hardy. Ideal for mixed containers & the landscape. Salt spray & wildlife tolerant.

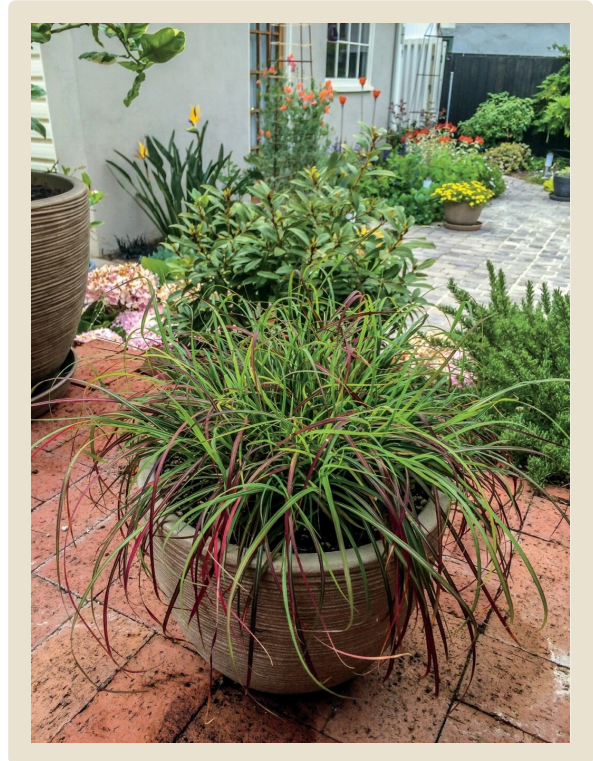
