# Chandler

Quarter size plus, flavorful fruit, is produced mid to late season, over a relatively long period, sometimes up to 6 weeks. High chill hour requirement.

For best fruiting, plant with other Northern Highbush varieties such as 'Bluecrop' or 'Blue Gold'.

'Chandler' Northern Highbush blueberry produces the largest blueberries to date.

Burgundy to orange Fall foliage color.

Full sun with regular water & fertility.

Very wildlife friendly.

Very pollinator friendly.
